

ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, the Government have last revised the stipend paid to Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs), Non-Service Post Graduate Degree / Diploma and Higher. Speciality (DM/ M.Ch.) students studying in Government Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu as follows:-

The Government had also ordered for an annual increase of Rs.600/- for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internee (CRRIs) and Rs.1000/- for non-service Post Graduate / Diploma / High Speciality students.

2. Resident Doctors Association in their Representation second read above, has stated that the stipend being paid to Non - service Post Graduate students of Government Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu is lower than some State Government or Central Government Medical Colleges and requested to revise the same. Similarly, the Non service Post Graduates have also requested the Government to increase their stipend.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to take a decision on the enhancement of stipend to the CRRi students/Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students and issue necessary orders.

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to enhance the rates of stipend to the CRRIs, Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students as per the time need. The Government accordingly do and hereby direct that the rate of stipend to the CRRIs, Non service Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students be enhanced as follows:

5. The Government also direct that an automatic annual increase of 3% to the previous year stipend shall be allowed. This order shall take effect from the date of issue of order. Annual hike will be from 1st April of every year. For example for the Post Graduate Degree students, for the next academic year (2022-2023) the stipend would be Rs.48,000/- + Rs,1,440/- = Rs.49,440/-, for second year Rs.49,000/- + Rs.1470/- +Rs.50,470/- and for third year students it would be Rs.50,000/- +
